Souvenir chairs Jim Evans and Donna Hough reported they have ordered three styles of hoodie sweatshirts that should be popular with the students. Members discussed the purchase of cinch bags with an eagle logo and decided to order a small quantity to see how well they sell. A new hat style was ordered to replace a discontinued one. Members volunteered to sell souvenirs at the school during events on August 9th, 10th, 11th, and 18th.

Ad sale chair Cathy Evans reported sales are down considerably from past years. A total of 88 ads have been sold with \$17,875.00 collected.
