

2012 SOUTHEAST SECTION of the SOCIETY OF EXPERIMENTAL TEST PILOTS SCHOLARSHIP

The Southeast Section of the SETP will award one graduating senior who will pursue a technical college degree with a \$1,000, one year, unrestricted grant to assist them with their college costs.

The scholarship will be awarded to one student only, with students competing from the following high schools: Ft Walton Beach, Choctaw, Niceville, Walton, Crestview, and NWFSC Collegiate. The following criteria will be used to select the winning student, with particular emphasis on the essay:

- 1000 word essay
- Attached Scholarship Application
- Two Teacher Reports
- School Report

The 1000 word essay will be an original work with two parts. First, what technical degree the student plans to pursue and why they are interested in it, and second, an explanation of a recent technical or scientific breakthrough the student is very interested in and why.

The winning student will be announced during the luncheon of the 24 Feb 2012 SE Section SETP symposium held at the Ramada Plaza Beach Resort. Additionally, the top five students will be hosted at the symposium with registration and luncheon fees paid for by SETP. (No accommodations, transportation or travel fees will be provided or paid for.) The day-long symposium will include approximately ten technical briefs presented by test pilots concerning recent flight test programs and a presentation by a distinguished speaker at the luncheon.

The 1000 word essay, application, teacher reports and school report must be returned to your High School's Guidance Department by Monday, February 13, 2012, 2:00 p.m.
