Call to Order:

- Heather Kilbey, Chairman, called the regular meeting of NHS SAC to order at 6:35 AM.

Old Business:

- Chairman Kilbey reviewed Old Minutes from the March 15, 2011 meeting and called for a motion to approve. Susan Bubel moved the motion be accepted, seconded by Cindy Belcher and passed unanimously.

Financial report:

- Dr. Smith informed SAC there was approximately \$1500.00 of A+ funds left over for NHS. She proposed the funds be transferred to our budget and used for substitute pay. Chairman Kilbey called for a motion to approve. Susan Bubel moved the motion be accepted, seconded by Jocelyn Donahue and passed unanimously.

New Business:

- Emily Day, SGA President, did a presentation on the new addendums added to the SGA Constitution. She said the Constitution outlined duties and purpose of the NHS SGA. Two big additions were inclusion of the ICC and adding a Parliamentarian. There was discussion of fees associated with ICC.

Principal report:

- Dr. Smith informed SAC of the following new testing requirements for this year:
 - Prep for Computerized Math Testing
 - Administration of Computerized of Math Testing
 - Administration of Math for College Readiness
 - Seniors to NWFSC for English 4 College Prep
 - Algebra 1 EOC Exam
- FCAT Testing was held the week of April 11-15.
- ROTC Awards will be held at 9AM on Wednesday, April 20th.
- The Anne T. Mitchell Awards for Seniors will be held at NWFSC on April 26th at 6 PM.
- Okaloosa Applied Technology Center will host two sessions of summer school this year.
- National Honor Society Induction has been moved from April 26th to April 27th at 6:30 PM.
- Okaloosa County Art Show will be held April 21st from 6-7 PM.
- Dr. Smith reviewed the 2011/2012 Budget Process with the SAC.
- Since NHS Spring tryouts must not interfere with middle school activities; it does conflict a bit with our AP testing.
- We will be doing an evaluation of low prevalence courses.
- Principal Marcus Chambers spoke to SAC regarding the NHS budget for next year and said we should receive it tomorrow from the district. Our budget will be built on current registration numbers, which at present is 1840 students. The state has changed the definition of "core class", which reduced the number of core classes from around 800 last year to about 290-300 this year. We will indeed have difficult decisions to make regarding our budget. Mr. Chamber has asked Ms. McInnis to look at classes that had the least number of students this year and over the course of years in order to help decide which classes to cut. There was discussion of incoming students from Fort Bragg and how that would affect our budget.

Announcements and Discussion:

- Jim Evans said the Booster Club is still accepting sign-ups for Project Graduation. At this time we only have 129 signed up. He asked everyone to encourage students to sign up. Baker will participate with us again this year. Volunteers are still needed to help that night at Big Kahunas and serving breakfast when we return.

- The Booster Club will host an “Appreciation Dessert” on May 4th to thank the staff for all their hard work.
- The NHS staff and Booster Club will host a retirement reception for Dr. Smith on May 23rd, between 3:00-5:00 PM at First United Methodist Church in Niceville.
- Chairman Kilbey said we would be taking nominations for SAC Officers for 2011/12 thru summer and vote around open house. The Nominating Committee to elect officers for next year is Jim Evans, Kathy Gaubron, Jocelyn Donahoo, Jennifer Russell and Amanda Brady.
- Board Member Melissa Thrush said the Board is looking at several different options/possibilities in order to balance the budget for next year.
- Emily Day reminded everyone that NHS was hosting a Blood Drive today.

Chairman Kilbey called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Susan Bubel moved the motion be accepted, seconded by Jodi Maker, and unanimously accepted. Meeting adjourned at 7:22 A.M.
